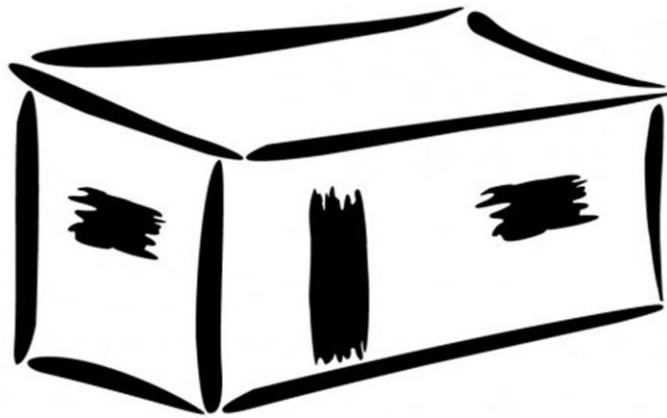

2018 HS STUDENT IMPACT MISSIONS TRIP

Eligibility: current 9th -12th graders

What: In just one week teams transform an otherwise empty lot into a safe and secure home - complete with cement foundation, electricity, windows and doors. As a result of this experience, each family receives a tangible symbol of the faithfulness and unconditional love of Jesus Christ. As volunteers gain perspective on the extreme poverty that exists in our world, so do these families better understand God's plan for their lives and His deep desire to take care of their needs.

Cost: The approximate cost of the trip is **\$1600-\$1800** depending on airfare and the number of participants. The simple breakdown of the cost is \$1100 for travel expenses, \$440 for building materials and \$260 for living expenses in the DR.

Additional expenses include:

- a couple meals while travelling
- a passport if you don't have one- \$80-\$110
- lunch on Friday in DR
- snacks at the canteen in DR
- appropriate clothing, basic tools and toiletries

Requirements- I am committing to fulfill the pre-trip team requirements:

- **attend an informational meeting with at least one parent on Sunday, December 3rd at 4:30 pm at the church**
- attend all training and team building meetings
- read the short book provided after you apply
- pray for the financial need of each team member
- enlist the prayer support of at least three non-relatives
- participate in the group fundraising events
